4:30 pm – arrive campsite and set up camp site  
5:45 pm – leave campsite for dinner at mess hall  
7:00 pm – return to campsite  
8:00 – 9:30 pm – campfire and cracker barrel  
10:00 pm – lights out

6:00 am – wake up call  
6:30 am – arrive at mess hall for breakfast
