● OA FALL CONCLAVE – THIS FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 17 – 19.

● 9TH ANNUAL SKILL-O-RAMA – OCTOBER 1 – OCTOBER 3.

A permission slip for the ninth annual Troop 219 Skill-O-Rama at Silver Lake Park is included as page 3 of this handout. Scouts are reminded that a common 3 season equipment list is on the troop website and to make sure that they bring appropriate clothing for the weather, including rain gear regardless of the forecast.

Scouts should NOT be packing excessive gear, and all gear should be packed in appropriate containers. Immense plastic tubs, and plastic garbage bags are NOT appropriate for our campouts. Backpacks and duffle bags are considerably more appropriate.

Every patrol should be making sure that any and all program assignments for this event are being taken care of.

● SUMMER [CAMP] RESULTS

A chart of completed merit badges turned in over the summer, including summer camp is reproduced on the back of this page. Please check it for accuracy – note that while quite a few merit badges were earned at Trail to Eagle, none of them are listed in that chart since forms have yet to be turned in to the troop.

Original partial merit badge forms are being returned to each scout. It is each Scout's responsibility to locate a merit badge counselor locally to complete these badges. The original partial merit badge form is the ONLY proof that exists of your completion of the specific requirements on that form – if you loose the partial merit badge form you start over, using the then current requirements. Partial merit badges are not tracked and cannot be replaced!!!! Treat them like cash.

Summer camp physical forms are also being returned to each scout and adult. A summer camp physical form may be used for as many as three years, simply by updating the information. If your summer camp physical still has life left in it, you should keep it in a safe place until its time to take it out, dust it off, update the information and turn it in for next year. Otherwise you'll need to start over with a new form and possibly a new physician signature.
