## • Upcoming Due Dates and Activities

- **Recharter:** It is approaching unit recharter time. Mr. Cox has sent out the paperwork explaining the process and dates for both Scouts and adults.
  - **Scout Registration:** If you have not received a letter please see Mr. Cox, Mr. Hussar or Mr. Miller. Paperwork and recharter fees were due back in to the Troop by December 4, 2006. As stated in the letter, if a family needs assistance with the recharter fees they should see Mr. Miller, our Treasurer, or any adult Leader to discuss your situation. **If you have not turned in your payment to Mr. Miller you need to do so by Monday, December 18, 2006.**
  - **Adult Registration:** We are collecting the annual adult registration for Committee Members and Assistant Scoutmasters at this time also. The amount is \$13 for the year. This amount is the same as last year and includes the national registration fee. Boys Life is an additional \$12.00. This would bring your total payment to \$25.00.

## **NEW ITEM for New Year's Eve**

- **Jubil'Eve Service Project:** This will be a multi-part service project. All we are asked to do is to assemble the luminaries and then to put them out and light them. Another group will collect them at the end of the evening.
  - I have scheduled a work session for Thursday, December 28, 2006 from 7:00 P.M. until we are done. We will have four hundred bags, candles and weights. We need to place a candle into a weight and put the weight and candle into a bag. We will store these in a room at the church.
  - At 4:00 P.M. on Sunday, December 31, 2006, we will meet at the church to place the bags along Leroy St. from just south of St. Jude's Episcopal Church north to just north of the Fenton United Methodist Church. We will need to determine the spacing to cover both sides of Leroy St. as well as to put them along the sidewalks to various churches or businesses participating. After they are all placed then we will go back and light the candle in each bag. This all has to be done by 6:00 P.M.
