Thanks to all but especially to the parents who came out on Saturday to run concessions and the man the front gates and collect monies as the Cubs and Webelos were arriving. Thanks also to those Scouts and leaders who stayed one or both nights as well as being there for the day on Saturday. Mr. Miller has not given me the full count for Cub Scouts who came out for the day and the Webelos count is only for those Webelos and partners who camped AND ate with us. I believe that there were more Webelos in attendance than these numbers would indicate.

We have been asked to set up two water stations during the Fenton Area C.R.O.P. Walk on Sunday, October 5, 2008. Each station will require two to three Scouts and your duties will be to have cups of water ready for any walkers and to clean up the area along your section of the route if they drop their cups when they are through with them.

Dave Rainer is my contact person. He said that the two stations should be set up at 2:00 P.M. One will be on the corner of Jefferson and N. Adelaide Sts. And the other one just south of State Road School in the small parking lot that was established for people using the playscape at the school. They will provide a couple of chairs, a card table, trash bag and cups. We should plan on providing 6 gallons of water for the first station and probably not as much for the second station.

Hopefully on Monday, September 29, 2008, we will have at least one adult and 4-6 Scouts recruited to man the two stations. Only 2-3 Scouts are required per station.

The remaining committee meeting dates are: October 15 and November 20, 2008; January 14; February 18, March 18, April 15, May 13 and August 19, 2009.
