• Summer Camp Physicals

Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, 4H or any Summer Camp requiring a doctor exam. Youth and Adults. \$15.00. Wednesday, April 22, 2009, **5:00 P.M. until done** (Please be there by 6:00 P.M. at the latest). Dr. Ewin Delange's Office, 3273 Davison Rd., Lapeer, next to the Polar Palace Ice Arena. Adults bring proof of negative TB test. Wear shorts and t-shirts. I suggest you take page 4 of the Tall Pine Council Annual Health and Medical Record with you with your name and DOB filled out on the bottom. • First Year Scout Campouts-wrap-up and upcoming in April:

The second "First Year Scout" campout will be held on Saturday, April 25 and Sunday, April 26, 2009 at Camp Holaka. This will be held in conjunction with a backpacking/Wilderness campout for the rest of the Scouts. The preliminary details on the wilderness campout were discussed and will be finalized tonight, Monday, April 20, 2009.

We will depart from the Fenton Collision parking lot on Saturday at 8:30 A.M. and will return to the same location on Sunday morning at approximately 10:30 A.M. The permission slip and payment should be returned on Monday, April 20, 2009. That is why this handout has been email to all of the Scout families.

• Dorchester International Brotherhood Camporee

The 20th Dorchester International Brotherhood Camporee (DIBC) will take place on Friday, May 8, Saturday, May 9 and Sunday, May 10, 2009 in London, Ontario Canada. We will depart on Friday from the parking lot at Fenton Collision at 4:00 P.M. Please arrive BEFORE that time so that your personal gear may be loaded up.

Mr. Miller had Permission Slips available at the Court of Honor on Monday, March 23, 2009. He still has paper copies of the paperwork for anyone who still needs it. I will include parts of Mr. Miller's email to me again for everyone:

"This will be our troop's 13th year of attending this international camporee. Beginning this year we will have a new requirement of a valid passport. The previous requirement of a State ID and birth certificate will NO longer be acceptable. There still is enough time to get an expedited passport in time for the camporee if you apply soon - contact the post office for passport information. The permission slip will be due on Monday, April 27, 2009."

• Summer Camp Payments

You may make payments to Mr. Miller for summer camp at any Troop meeting. The full payment must be made to the Troop by Monday, May 11, 2009 to be eligible for the discounted price. After that date the full price is increased by \$20.00 per Scout and \$10.00 per adult. The Deadline for Camperships is the end of April so if someone needs financial assistance see Mr. Miller-Troop Treasurer, Mr. McDonald-Troop Committee Chairman or Mr. Hussar-Scoutmaster for an application.

• Summer Camp Tall Pine Council Annual Health and Medical Record

You will need to use this form if you are going to summer camp. The details for getting to it are listed above. You may use a prior physical, sports physical or whatever. The physical exam must have been completed after July 7, 2006 for Scouts and adults under age 40 or after July 7, 2008 for adults over age 40. Insert it in front of page four of the new form. Full dates are required for immunizations or you may attach your Scout's Immunization Record. We will need a copy of your Medical Insurance Coverage card. I will make a copy of all final paperwork and turn the copy in to Camp Tapico. I have been told we will get the physical exam page back but would rather be safe than sorry. All of the other paperwork will be kept by Council for three years before being shredded.

• Summer Camp Swim Checks

Summer Camp swim checks were originally announced as being held on Monday, May 18, 2009. After reviewing an email from their coordinator I have made the decision to move them to Thursday, May 21, 2009. The cost will be \$3.00 per person. Time is set from 7-9 P.M.

The date was changed as we would be limited to 2 lanes for swim checks followed by our open swim. On Thursday we can have up to 4 lanes for swim checks and then our open swim. ALSO, Monday, May 18, 2009, is our last chance to polish up our marching for the Memorial Day Parade on Monday, May 25, 2009.
